



Huntsville USBC Youth #80403 Winter Doubles Tournament Saturday, December 15, 2007 at 10 AM

1. Tournament is USBC certified open to all eligible 2007-08 Huntsville USBC Youth members.
2. Tournament consist of a Doubles event any combination of gender.
3. Multiple entry or pacers are not allowed.
4. Entrants will bowl three games on a pair of lanes. Lanes will be dressed prior to squad.
5. Entrants will receive 10 minutes of practice.
6. There will be a minimum of two proportional divisions based on entering averages of entries.
7. Handicap is 90% of 400. Total pins plus handicap will determine winners.
8. Entries open Saturday, November 10, 2007 and close Saturday, December 8, 2007. Entries postmarked the first post office business day following the entry closing date will be accepted.
9. Itemized entry fee per team: Bowling fee \$13.20; Award \$6.80; Total \$20.00.
10. Averages will be verified and incorrect averages will be corrected by tournament management. In descending order:
 - a. Highest 2006-07 HUSBC Youth 21 game minimum book average.
 - b. Highest 2007-08 HUSBC Youth league average, 21 game minimum, as of 12/08/07.
 - c. Scratch.
11. Payment of entry fee must accompany entry application to be accepted and will not be refunded.
12. Fees will be paid by check or money order payable to the Huntsville USBC Association.
13. Awards: All collected award fees will be returned 100% in each Division.
 - a. Plaques will be awarded based on a minimum of 1 per 7 team entries.
 - b. Scholarships: 1st Place - \$50 per bowler, 2nd Place – \$40 per bowler, 3rd Place – \$30 per bowler.
14. In case of a tie involving awards, duplicates will be made.
15. In case of first place ties, co-champions will be declared.
16. Participants will check in 30 minutes prior to scheduled match. Any player arriving after the game has started is allowed to bowl and the score(s) will count beginning in the frame then being bowled. **NO SCORES ARE GIVEN FOR FRAMES MISSED.**
17. Scoring errors must be reported within 15 minutes of the conclusion of the squad. Any protest must be confirmed in writing to tournament management within 72 hours. Each protest must be specific.
18. Only bowlers and tournament management are allowed and food or drink products will not be allowed in the non-carpeted bowling area.
19. Entrants will be allowed to have one (1) bowling ball on the ball return at all times.
20. Proper attire must be worn. Participants may wear long pants, shorts, skirt or dress. Fingertips may not extend beyond hem of short when arms are fully extended downward at sides. Shorts are to be hemmed and cannot be bicycle or exercise type. No tank, halter, or abbreviated tops, sleeveless tee shirts, hats or caps may be worn. Decision on attire will be made by tournament official.
21. No flash cameras allowed. Smoking will not be allowed in the participation area.
22. Entrants can be removed from competition for conduct derogatory to include but not limited to the use of foul language or gestures (USBC Rule 17d).
23. The USBC SMART program will be used to administer scholarship funds (USBC Rule 301c).
24. Tournament management will decide any question not covered by rules (USBC Rule 329).
